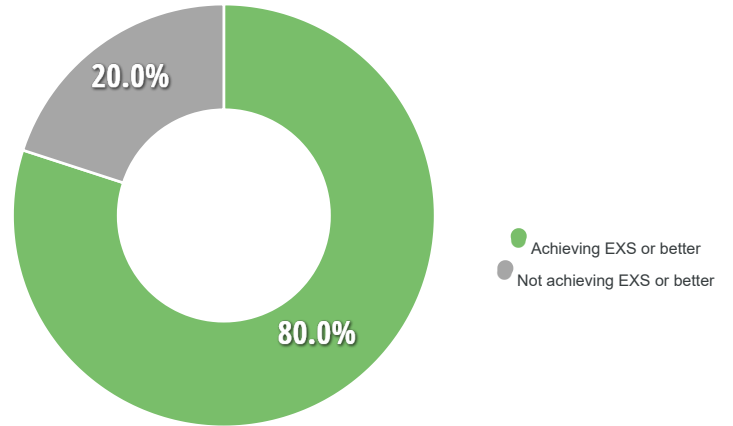

KEY STAGE 1 | MATHS EXPECTED STANDARD

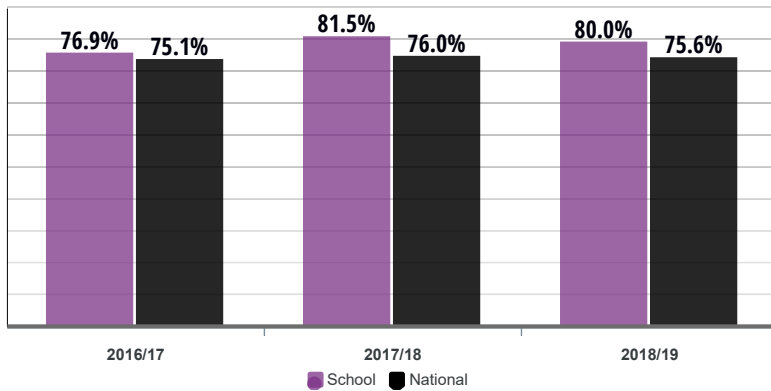
From a cohort of **30 pupils** in your school at the end of Key Stage 1, **80.0%** achieved the expected standard in Maths, a total of **24 pupils**.

23.3% achieved a greater depth in Maths, a total of **7 pupils**.

Key Stage 1: Maths Expected Standard | Trend



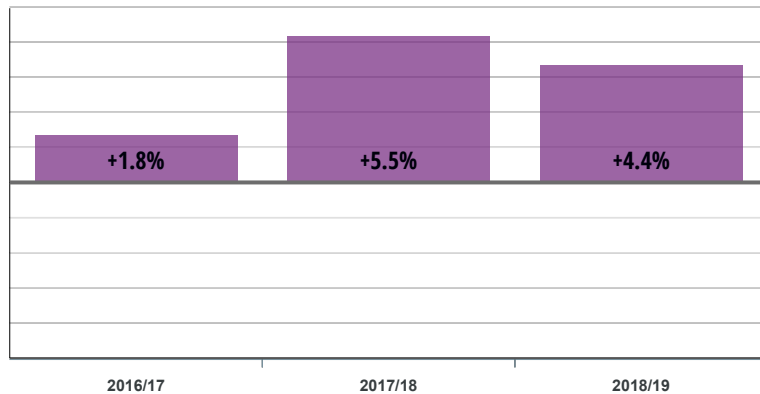
Your school's expected standard percentage in Maths has **decreased by 1.5%** from **81.5%** in 2017/18 to **80.0%** in 2018/19.

This is equivalent to approximately **the same number of** pupils achieving the expected standard in 2018/19 compared to 2017/18.

Your school's average for the 3 academic years is **80.0%**.

COMPARISON | NATIONAL

Key Stage 1: Maths Expected Standard | Comparison Trend



80.0% achieved the expected standard in Maths in your school, **4.4% higher than** than the National average of **75.6%**.

This is equivalent to **1 more** pupils in your school achieving the expected standard compared to the National average.

Your school has been above the National average **3 times** in the last 3 academic years for the expected standard in Maths.

Your school's relative change for expected standard in Maths has **declined by 4.8%**, from **+3.7%** in 2017/18 to **-1.1%** in 2018/19 when compared to the National average.

While your school average for expected standard in Maths has **decreased by 1.5%**, from **81.5%** in 2017/18 to **80.0%** in 2018/19, the National average **decreased by 0.4%**, from **76.0%** in 2017/18 to **75.6%** in 2018/19.

RANK

Your school is in **percentile 35** when compared to all schools nationally for the expected standard in Maths.

The schools in the same decile as you had between **79.5%** and **81.4%** of their cohort achieve the expected standard in Maths.

Your school **fell 2** places in the percentile rankings between 2017/18 and 2018/19, from **33** to **35**.
