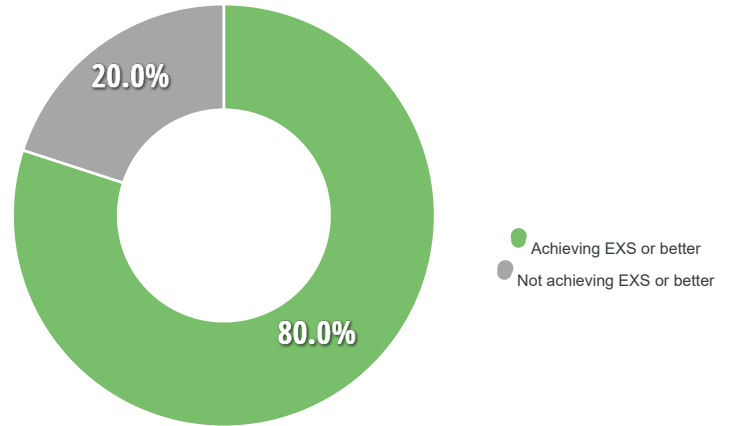

KEY STAGE 1 | READING EXPECTED STANDARD

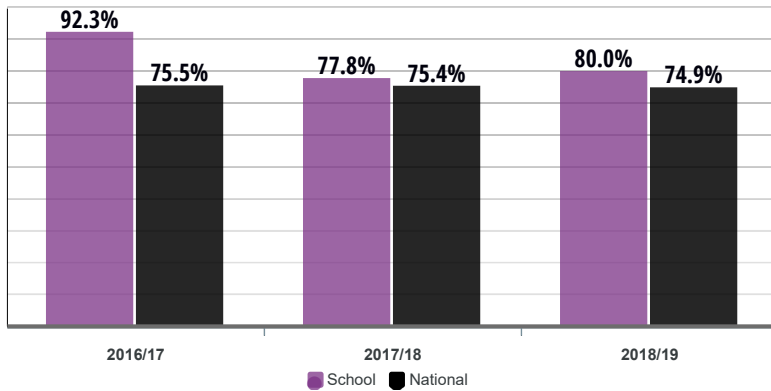
From a cohort of **30 pupils** in your school at the end of Key Stage 1, **80.0%** achieved the expected standard in Reading, a total of **24 pupils**.

26.7% achieved a greater depth in Reading, a total of **8 pupils**.

Key Stage 1: Reading Expected Standard | Trend



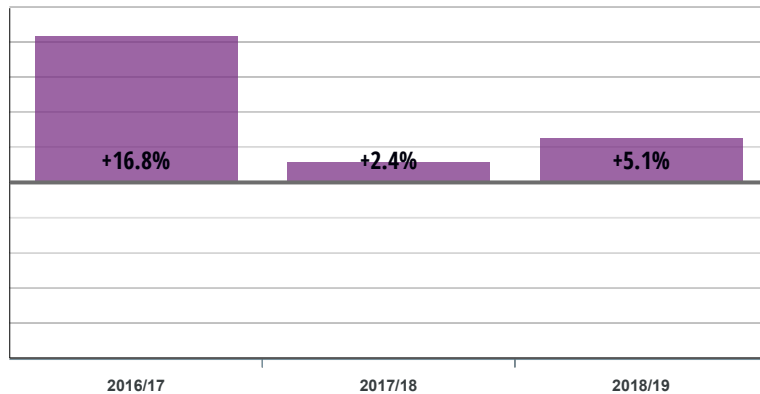
Your school's expected standard percentage in Reading has **increased by 2.2%** from **77.8%** in 2017/18 to **80.0%** in 2018/19.

This is equivalent to approximately **1 more** pupils achieving the expected standard in 2018/19 compared to 2017/18.

Your school's average for the 3 academic years is **81.4%**.

COMPARISON | NATIONAL

Key Stage 1: Reading Expected Standard | Comparison Trend



80.0% achieved the expected standard in Reading in your school, **5.1% higher than** than the National average of **74.9%**.

This is equivalent to **2 more** pupils in your school achieving the expected standard compared to the National average.

Your school has been above the National average **3 times** in the last 3 academic years for the expected standard in Reading.

Your school's relative change for expected standard in Reading has **improved by 17.1%**, from **-14.4%** in 2017/18 to **+2.7%** in 2018/19 when compared to the National average.

While your school average for expected standard in Reading has **increased by 2.2%**, from **77.8%** in 2017/18 to **80.0%** in 2018/19, the National average **decreased by 0.5%**, from **75.4%** in 2017/18 to **74.9%** in 2018/19.

RANK

Your school is in **percentile 33** when compared to all schools nationally for the expected standard in Reading.

The schools in the same decile as you had between **78.9%** and **81.2%** of their cohort achieve the expected standard in Reading.

Your school **rose 14** places in the percentile rankings between 2017/18 and 2018/19, from **47** to **33**.
