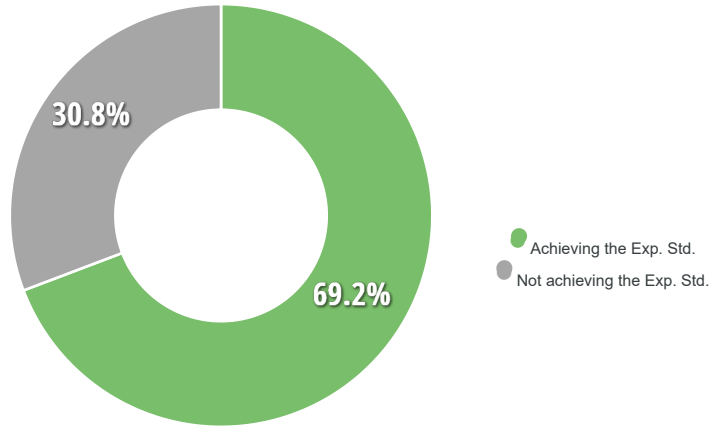
KEY STAGE 2 | MATHS EXPECTED STANDARD

From a cohort of **26 pupils** in your school at the end of Key Stage 2, **69.2%** achieved the expected standard in Maths, a total of **18 pupils**.

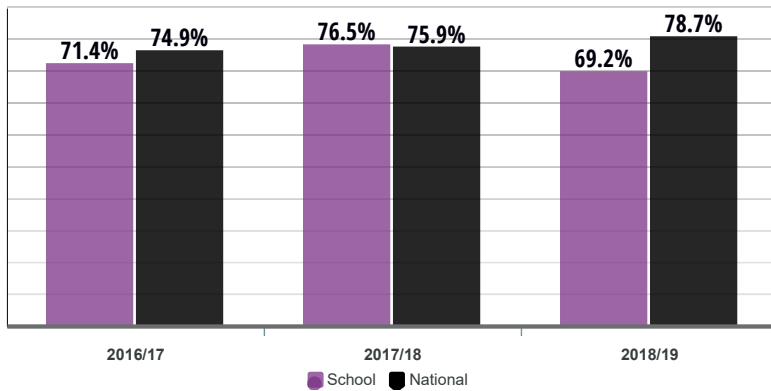
30.8% achieved a scaled score < 100 in Maths in your school, a total of **8 pupils**.

34.6% achieved a higher standard in Maths, with a scaled score equal to or greater than 110, or equivalent TA result, a total of **9 pupils**.

Key Stage 2: Maths Expected Standard | Trend



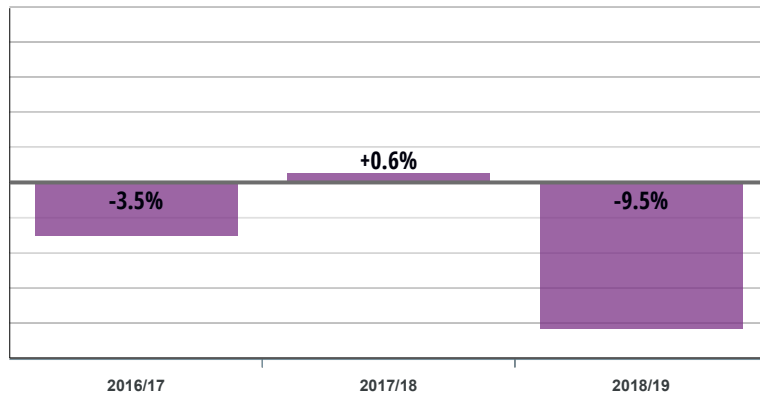
Your school's expected standard percentage in Maths has **decreased by 7.3%** from **76.5%** in 2017/18 to **69.2%** in 2018/19.

This is equivalent to approximately **2 fewer** pupils achieving the expected standard in 2018/19 compared to 2017/18.

Your school's average for the 3 academic years is **71.9%**.

COMPARISON | NATIONAL

Key Stage 2: Maths Expected Standard | Comparison Trend



69.2% achieved the expected standard in Maths in your school, **9.5% lower than** than the National average of **78.7%**.

This is equivalent to **2 fewer** pupils in your school achieving the expected standard compared to the National average.

Your school has been above the National average **1 time** in the last 3 academic years for the expected standard in Maths.

Your school's relative change for expected standard in Maths has **declined by 14.2%**, from **+4.1%** in 2017/18 to **-10.1%** in 2018/19 when compared to the National average.

While your school average for expected standard in Maths has **decreased by 7.3%**, from **76.5%** in 2017/18 to **69.2%** in 2018/19, the National average **increased by 2.8%**, from **75.9%** in 2017/18 to **78.7%** in 2018/19.

RANK

Your school is in **percentile 80** when compared to all schools nationally for the expected standard in Maths.

The schools in the same decile as you had between **69.2%** and **74.1%** of their cohort achieve the expected standard in Maths.

Your school **fell 24** places in the percentile rankings between 2017/18 and 2018/19, from **56** to **80**.
