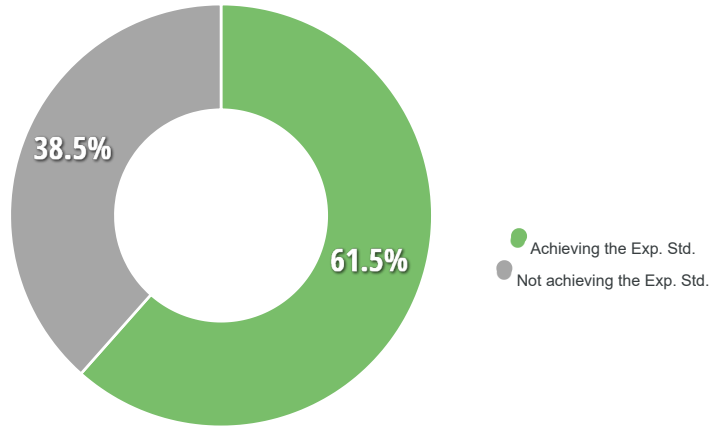
## KEY STAGE 2 | READING EXPECTED STANDARD

From a cohort of **26 pupils** in your school at the end of Key Stage 2, **61.5%** achieved the expected standard in Reading, a total of **16 pupils**.

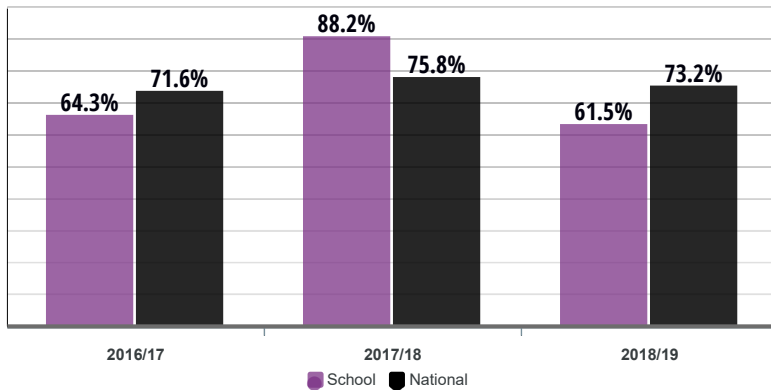
**38.5%** achieved a scaled score < 100 in Reading in your school, a total of **10 pupils**.

**26.9%** achieved a higher standard in Reading, with a scaled score equal to or greater than 110, or equivalent TA result, a total of **7 pupils**.

Key Stage 2: Reading Expected Standard | Trend



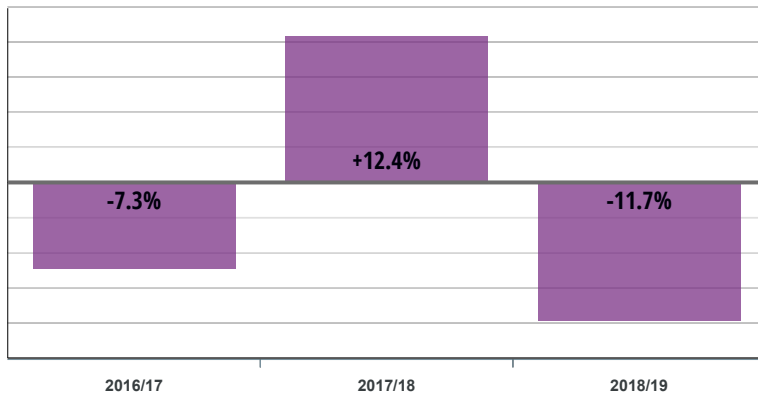
Your school's expected standard percentage in Reading has **decreased by 26.7%** from **88.2%** in 2017/18 to **61.5%** in 2018/19.

This is equivalent to approximately **7 fewer** pupils achieving the expected standard in 2018/19 compared to 2017/18.

Your school's average for the 3 academic years is **70.2%**.

# COMPARISON | NATIONAL

## Key Stage 2: Reading Expected Standard | Comparison Trend



**61.5%** achieved the expected standard in Reading in your school, **11.7% lower than** than the National average of **73.2%**.

This is equivalent to **3 fewer** pupils in your school achieving the expected standard compared to the National average.

Your school has been above the National average **1 time** in the last 3 academic years for the expected standard in Reading.

Your school's relative change for expected standard in Reading has **declined by 43.8%**, from **+19.7%** in 2017/18 to **-24.1%** in 2018/19 when compared to the National average.

While your school average for expected standard in Reading has **decreased by 26.7%**, from **88.2%** in 2017/18 to **61.5%** in 2018/19, the National average **decreased by 2.6%**, from **75.8%** in 2017/18 to **73.2%** in 2018/19.

# RANK

Your school is in **percentile 83** when compared to all schools nationally for the expected standard in Reading.

The schools in the same decile as you had between **56.4%** and **63.2%** of their cohort achieve the expected standard in Reading.

Your school **fell 61** places in the percentile rankings between 2017/18 and 2018/19, from **22** to **83**.
