Primary PE & Sports Premium

Background

The government are spending over £450 million on this funding over the 3 academic years 2013 to 2014, 2014 to 2015 and 2015 to 2016. This funding is being jointly provided by the Department for Education and the Department for Culture, Media & Sport with the money going directly to primary schools.

Purpose

The premium has to be used to fund improvements of PE and sport, for the benefit of primary aged pupils, in the academic year the funding is received to give the opportunity to develop a healthy lifestyle.

At Elsecar Holy Trinity, it is currently the SLT who have the responsibility for developing sport and effective use of the Sport Premium funding, although the long term plan is to delegate this to a sports coordinator. We already have a good reputation for our sport and PE as we strive to promote healthy and active lifestyles and aim to provide sporting opportunities for all our pupils. We welcome this additional funding which has allowed us to further enhance our provision, including entering competitions and it has led to an increase in participation of all different sports.

Funding

Elsecar Holy Trinity C.E (VA) Primary School receives £8,000 plus a premium of £5 per pupil in Years 1-6 (January 2014) which equates to £8,650.

This extra funding has meant we have been able to:

1) Invest in the Team Activ Sport Partnership Programme which provides the school with the following:

- A full organised annual programme of competitions/tournaments in addition to the local pyramid.
- Participation, inclusion and excellence opportunities in sport.
- CPD *(staff training) for curriculum PE.
- Local School Network meetings to support our PE & Sports Leader in her role developing PE & sport within school.
- Promotion and development of links to local sports clubs
- Central co-ordination of school sport programmes in Barnsley area
- Purchase of PE schemes of work to incorporate the new national curriculum and ensure clear progress in skills throughout the year groups.

Funding cont.

- 2) Purchase of specialist sport equipment including a school football kit.
- 3) Buying into the local schools pyramid to provide competitions.
- 4) Transport to and from competitions.
- 5) Purchasing of Phonics bibs to links literacy with physical activities

Evidence of impact

Buying into the Team Activ partnership has meant the school has been invited to all sporting events in the borough leading to an increase in participation in these competitive events.

The school is now well stocked with equipment for all sports and activities planned for the school year. The introduction of a full set of gym mats has meant that all the children in a year group have been able to fully participate in gymnastics sessions.

Training of the lunchtime staff and the purchase of more playtime sporting activities has led to more children being active at both play time and lunch times.

Increased attendance at after school sporting clubs

Increased engagement of staff in our school's PE and Sport initiative.
