Spotlight on Year 2

This week we have been honing our arithmetic skills and finding little tricks to help us remember strategies to support our learning. These have been things like circling the maths sign in the middle of a calculation or drawing base ten to help us add and subtract two digit numbers. In Literacy we have been learning about the subordinating conjunctions when, if and because. We used inspiration pictures from our

Florence Nightingale topic to construct sentences. We are focusing on how to write a diary entry as though we were Florence Nightingale. In Science we have been looking at seeds and bulbs and what they need to be able to germinate successfully. We also started planning our enquiry into observing the growth of seeds under different conditions over time. We have focused on learning the language of experiments such as prediction, hypothesis and method.
