Art Week

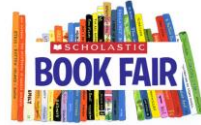


Next week we are having an art week in school where children will be learning lots of new and exciting skills. Children will be learning all about famous artists and creating their very own masterpiece by the end of the week.

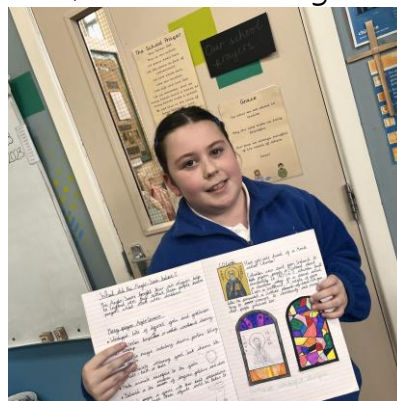
