We would like to celebrate this love of history by holding a very exciting competition to share the knowledge which your child has learnt. To share this learning, your child can create a poster, a model, a PowerPoint presentation, or anything else creative to showcase the knowledge which they have learnt! Please check the table below to show what your child has been learning:

Year group	History unit covered
Foundation	Know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now, drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class.
1	Kings, Queens and Castles – Year 1 have been learning all about our Monarch King Charles III and what it means to be a Monarch. They also visited Conisbrough Castle to support their knowledge journey.
2	The Great Fire of London – children have been learning all about what London was like in 1666 well as the significant events that took place during this time.
3	Stone Age and Iron Age – children have been learning all about the early Stone Age (Palaeolithic) as well as what life was like during the Mesolithic Age.
4	The Romans – children have been learning all about what the Roman Empire was in Britain as well as what society was like.
5	The Vikings and Anglo – Saxons – children have learnt who the Vikings were and which period in history they belonged to. We have also explored what life was like during the Anglo – Saxon times. We also visited Jorvik Viking Centre to support our knowledge journey.
6	<b>Mining</b> – children have learnt all about what life was like for people who worked down the mines in the 19 <sup>th</sup> and 20 <sup>th</sup> centuries. They have also visited the National Coal Mining Museum as part of their knowledge journey.

If you bring your creations back to school by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> November, we will be judging them and there will be winners from each class, who will receive a very special prize!
