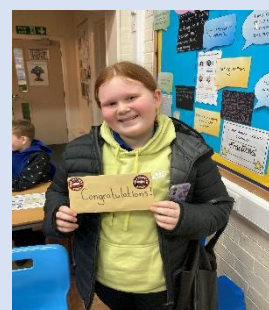
### Local Authority Comparison

Every two weeks we are able compare our attendance data against primary school across Barnsley. This is a useful tool which we can use to monitor our progress and gage the impact of the measures we are putting in place to raise attendance levels in school. Below are the most up to date figures available. As you will see we still have a high rate of unauthorised absences within school due to holidays taken within term time.

Attendance measure	Percentage	Ranking ⓘ
Overall attendance	93.7%	You are ranked 57 out of 70 schools
Overall absence	6.3%	You are ranked 58 out of 70 schools
Persistently absent	23.4%	You are ranked 66 out of 70 schools
Severely absent	0.6%	You are ranked 46 out of 70 schools
Authorised absence	3.6%	You are ranked 47 out of 70 schools
Unauthorised absence	2.7%	You are ranked 58 out of 70 schools
