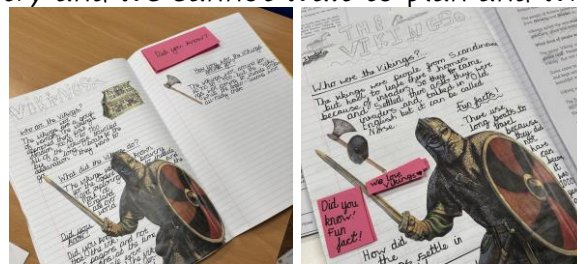
Christmas Jumper & Dinner Day
